Industrial Hygiene Task Force Update

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Purpose

- Enhance company-specific IH programs and exposure control efforts (asphalt fume (AF), respirable crystalline silica (RCS), formaldehyde)
- Characterize industry progress in controlling significant health risk to workers
- Allow evaluation of the feasibility and impact of proposed regulations or standards

Process

- IH QA/QC Task Force:
 - review of data for compliance with protocols
 - 6 member companies



2019 Activity

- Task force activity restarted late 2018, including new data administrator
- AF and RCS call for data March 2019
- Developed additional data protocol for formaldehyde; approved by EC
- AF and formaldehyde call for data October 2019



Company Participation

- 18 member companies have asphalt roofing plants that meet the criteria for AF, RCS, and formaldehyde data submission
- 15 have committed to participation; 14 have submitted data
- 13 submitted for RCS; 14 submitted for AF (13 both)
- 8 companies have submitted formaldehyde data, including all who produce fiberglass mat

Most Recent ARMA IH QA/QC Task Force Meetings

March 2019: AF & RCS call for data

- 4 companies submitted data
- Total Data Points Submitted and Reviewed:
 - RCS: 370 data points
 - AF: 74 data points

Oct / Nov 2019: AF & Formaldehyde call for data

- AF (7 companies): 398 data points
- Formaldehyde (8 companies): 638 data points reviewed



Formaldehyde Added to ARMA IH Database

- Formaldehyde IH Sampling Protocol approved by ARMA IH QA/QC Task Force in 6/2019
- First Formaldehyde data call went out with deadline of 9/06/2019

Formaldehyde Data Call Response

Number of Samples	Companies Participating	Plants Participating
638	8	39

- 350 data points reviewed, remainder to be reviewed 11/20.
- All of the ARMA companies producing fiberglass mat have submitted formaldehyde data.

- Continue accumulation and review of data
- Anticipate forthcoming quarterly submission deadlines
- Finalize data summary format for provision to participating companies
- Use data where approved by ARMA governance
