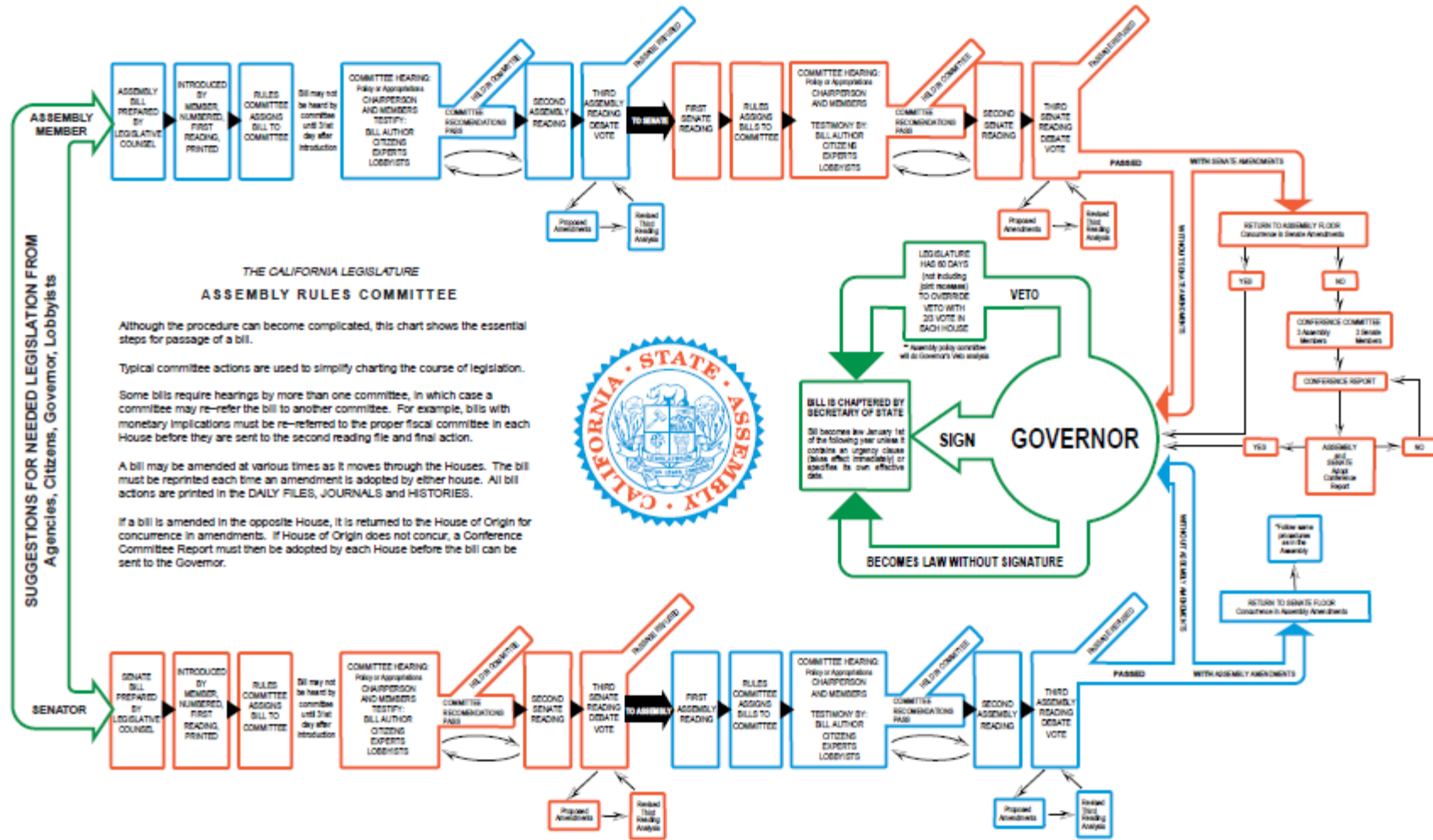
- Senate: Democratic “Mega” Majority
- Senate: 29-11
- Assembly 61-19
- Mod/New Dems
- 2020 Election Year
- 6 Senators Termed Out: Beall (D), Galgiani (D), Hill (D), Jackson (D), Monning (D), Morrell (R)

Legislative Session Schedule

- Entering 2nd year of 19/20 session
- **Jan 6** Legislature Reconvenes
- **Feb 21** Last day for bills to be introduced
- **Apr 2** Spring Recess begins upon adjournment
- **June 15** Budget Bill must be passed by midnight
- **July 2** Summer Recess
- **Aug 31** Last day for each house to pass bills

- National Media
- Governing by Executive Order and Social Media decrees
- Dynamex, Vaccinations, Death Penalty, Medical Pharma Benefit Negotiation
- 16.5% Veto rate, same as Gov Brown
- Undermanned, understaffed

AB 660
(Levine)

- ARMA Engagement
- Bill flies through Asm Natural Resources, Approps, And Asm Floor
- Squeaks out of Sen Energy
- Stalls in Senate Appropriations

Cool Roof Workshop

- 12/16 in Sacramento, CA
- Hosted by Asm Levine's Office
- Ronnen Levinson, LBL
- CEC Building Efficiency Standards Dept
Invited to Participate

2020 Lookahead

- AB 660 (Levine) still in Senate Approps
- ARMA developed Strategic Plan and Campaign for 2020
- Levine still lacks support required to move bill out of committee
- Outcome will be decided by Sen Approps, key Senate Democrats, and the Governor
